It helps them develop language and listening skills and prepares them to understand the written word. ... even after children learn to read by themselves, it's still important for you to read aloud together.

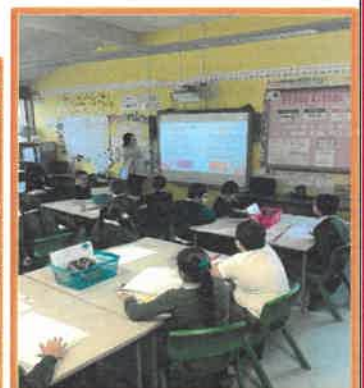
