I'm sure that you will be aware of the constantly changing Government guidance regarding COVID19. The most up-to-date requirements and changes with the isolation period is now 7 days from the point of symptoms or from the date of positive test if asymptomatic, on condition of two negative lateral flow tests undertaken on days 6 and day 7 at least 24 hours apart.
