



Year 3 Summer Term



Welcome back after the Easter break. We hope you feel refreshed and ready to go for the last term in Year 3.

Maths

As mathematicians, in Year 3 the children will be concentrating on fractions, horizontal/vertical and perpendicular lines. Children will learn about length, mass and volume. Money and statistics will also be a key focus in the second half term. Children will continue to develop mathematical skills and vocabulary. They will have the opportunity to build on their knowledge of fractions and apply this to other areas such as length and money. Children will be rehearsing the written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. In order for children to be successful with their multiplication and division work, they need to know their times tables facts. Please encourage your child to use TT Rockstar Maths and RME Maths regularly at home.

English

In English the children will be concentrating on writing sentences using a range of punctuation and conjunctions accurately. Children will be encouraged to use correct grammatical vocabulary and be able to recognise a range of different sentence types. Children will also be taught how to identify and use, nouns, verbs, adjectives and adverbs. The children will continue to develop their writing skills for the Golden Writing folder and show an enthusiastic stamina for writing. Children will have phonic based spellings each week, please help them practise at home. Additionally, please encourage your child to use Reading Eggs regularly.

Science

As scientists, the children will find out about forces and magnets. They will conduct investigations and learn how to carry out a fair test. Children will make predictions and use different ways to record their findings.

Religious Education

The children will be learning about Islamic beliefs.

Design and Technology

In DT, children will be planning and creating moving monsters.

P.E

This term there will be a focus on games. Children will be learning how to throw and catch using different apparatus.

History

History is taught chronologically, so Y3 children will be learning about the Romans.

Art

As artists, the children will develop the skills of making a building 3 dimensional.

Geography

In Geography, children will be learning about countries in Europe.

Music

As musicians, children are taught musical terms such as tempo, pulse and beat.



Computing

In Computing, children will be learning how to take screenshots and edit photographs.
