Year 4 Spring

Maths

We will begin our maths learning with a focus on multiplication and division methods, and solving word problems. Alongside this, we will continue to work on the accurate recall of our times tables. It is imperative that all children practise using TTRS.

English

This term, we will begin by using Micheal Morpurgo's 'Kensukes Kingdom' to support our writing. We will enhance our work by including a variety of sentence types and using ambitious vocabulary to engage our reader. We will continue to think carefully about punctuation throughout writing lessons. It would be great if parents/carers could listen to their children read daily in order to help them with the language and vocabulary shared in a text.

PSHEe

During the Spring Term, children will look at 'Living in the Wider World', where we discuss what it means to belong to a community, how our data is used and stored and making decisions about money and budgeting.

Thematic —Law and Order

"Law and Order" is a thematic unit, based on the concept of justice, with a key focus on citizenship. Pupils will look at the importance of leadership and the meaning of democracy and its origins, before moving on to how this applies practically in communities, both school-wide, locally and nationally.



PE

This term, the children will be taught a range of skills with Soccer 2000! We aim to try and get outside as much as possible.



Science

In Science, we will look at 'States of Matter' where we will look at materials and what makes them different. We will continue to build on our Scientific Enquiry skills when investigating ideas.
